



## **Tree Replacement Program**

The Tree Replacement Program is a cost-sharing program encouraging property owners to plant new trees on their property. The planting of new trees improves air quality, enhances the visual aesthetic of the community, and betters the quality of life for residents.

The following parameters pertain to participation in the Tree Replacement Program:

1. Residents are reimbursed 25% of the cost of a single new non-“native” tree or 75% of the cost of a single “native” tree planted on their property, excluding sales tax, delivery, and installation, not to exceed \$200.
2. Program dollars are disbursed as reimbursement after the purchase of a new tree.
3. Each household may participate in this program once every year.

Residents wishing to participate in this partnership program must submit a paid receipt itemizing the cost of the tree. Receipts can be mailed to or dropped off at:

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, the following trees shall not be planted on Village parkways and therefore do not qualify for reimbursement under this program:

- Box Elder
- Catalpa
- Mountain Ash
- Mulberry
- Poplar
- Soft Maple
- Tree of Heaven
- Willow
- Ash (all varieties)
