Weather Services Included:

**Weather Command® Snow & Ice Precipitation Warnings
Year Round Standard Package Basic Level Service (\$2700 for 12 Months of Service)**

Weather Command® meteorologists will provide advanced notification for operationally significant snow, sleet and freezing rain types of precipitation for the Village of Grayslake, from the First Precipitation Event to the Last Precipitation Event during the 2021-2022 Winter Season thru the end of this contract period.

Weather Command® will email a copy of the Snow & Ice Precipitation Warning Form. Weather Command® will also text you to notify that a Snow & Ice Precipitation Warning has been issued 24 Hours a Day / 7 Days a week.

Storm Updates will be sent by email/text on a regular basis during winter storm precipitation events.

Weather Command® Warm Season Basic Level Storm Warnings (Included)

Weather Command meteorologists will provide advanced notification of specific storm conditions that will impact the Village of Grayslake for the term of this contract listed below:

- Thunderstorms: Any Thunderstorms
- Winds: Sustained Winds of 30 MPH or greater.
- Rain: Rainfall 0.5" or greater in a 1 hour period.

Weather Command® will email a copy of the Warm Season Warning Form. Weather Command® will also text you to notify that a Warm Season Warning has been issued 24 Hours a Day / 7 Days a week.

Notification Calls & 24/7 Consultations are NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIC PACKAGE



Weather Command® Daily Operational Forecasts for 12 Months (Included)

The Village of Grayslake will receive once per day, an operational forecast for six forecast days for your location. The forecast will include high and low temperature, precipitation start time, end time, probability, amount, wind speed and direction and other weather parameters. The forecast will be sent by email.

**Certified Site-Specific Snowfall (CSSS)™ Website Winter Season Access
(Pricing \$300 first site for the 2021-2022 Season)**

Weather Command® meteorologists will generate a Certified Site-Specific Snowfall Event (CSSS)™ for our Snowfall Website within 72 hours after each Snow & Ice Precipitation Event for our coverage area from the First Event to the Last Event during the 2021-2022 Winter Season. The report will be accessed by our Certified Site-Specific Snowfall (CSSS)™ Website. The website and your specific reports will be available for viewing and printing through June 30th, 2022. You will have access to **1 location**.

**Certified Monthly Rainfall Report
(\$1200 for 12 months)**

Weather Command® meteorologists will provide at the conclusion of each month a monthly report of Rainfall for Grayslake. This form will be emailed out by the 5th day of the following month to a list of emails provided by Grayslake.

The Village of Grayslake agrees that all weather forecasts, warnings and data furnished to them under this agreement will be utilized only by the Village of Grayslake, and will not be redistributed to any other person or entity.

(All forecasts, warnings, and details therein are made subject to the inherent limitations of the science of Meteorology. Because of this, these warnings and the details therein should be considered supplementary to, and are not intended to replace, other pertinent weather information. There is a margin of error in all weather forecasting that must be acknowledged and accounted for.

For our Snowfall Reports: All details contained herein are made subject to the inherent limitations of the science of Meteorology. The data is based upon reports received from the National Weather Service and Cooperative Observers. Start and Stop times are taken from the nearest National Weather Service Observation Reporting Station. The data has been evaluated by our staff of professional meteorologists and determined to be accurate and representative of this location. We do reserve the right to make changes to this report upon receipt of further meteorological data if we deem it necessary.




Fee

In consideration thereof, the Village of Grayslake agrees to pay by Murray & Trettel, Inc. / Weather Command® the sum of \$4200. We will invoice you 50% of this contract \$2100 at the start of this contract with an additional \$2100 to be invoiced on October 1st. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt of each invoice.
