## **Fremont School District 79 & Mundelein High School District 120 to Receive 2021 Economic Development Award from Grayslake Economic Development Commission**

**Grayslake.** The Village of Grayslake's Economic Development Commission (EDC) has unanimously chosen to award the 2021 Economic Development Award to Fremont School District 79 & Mundelein High School District 120.

The Economic Development Award is given each year by the EDC to businesses, organizations, or individuals who promote an environment that provides for additional job opportunities and/or make significant contributions to the expansion of the community's tax base and generation of additional revenues in the area's economy.

Both Fremont School District 79 & Mundelein High School District 120 are being recognized for their leadership and foresight in support of the commencement of development of the 640-acre Cornerstone business park in Grayslake. The districts' assistance resulted in the successful recruitment effort to attract a new 1.4 million square foot logistics center. Future developments in the Cornerstone business park will create thousands of local jobs and greatly expand the local non-residential tax base through new business development.
